IT

- NOTE TO STUDENTS: **PDE PUPIL BOOK IS A MUST TO GUIDE YOU THROUGH THIS UNIT AND IS ON GOOGLE CLASSROOM / DRIVE.**
- P3 - Explain the fundamentals of a scripting language. You should really use coded examples but these can be very basic. Google the terms in the pupil book and see what you can come up with. If you really struggle just email me and I will see what I can do.
- M2 - Is all about how scripts / scripting can make a website better by adding functions. Usually quizzes, click menus, flashing or rotating things, pop ups etc are all controlled by scripts - the pupil book has a range of examples talk about them and how they make a webpage better. e.g. websites with more interactive and interesting content get more visitors and are more popular.
- D1 - How are the scripts implemented in different browsers. Use thew categories in the pupil book. Choose some of them not all and discuss. For example onload() means that when the browser loads the page the script will run. write() means the script will save information to a given location.
- P4 - Make sure your designs have lots of evidence of planning for CSS.
- D2 - How can your webpages be improved - you could use the ones from Unit 28 as a starting point but you should also discuss how some more scripts (say what they would do) would improve your website. You should also say some CSS improvements.
